

OPOA STANDING RULE

RETIREMENT/SEPARATION PARTIES

If a member of the OPOA separates from the City of Oxnard in good standing, he or she can be reimbursed by the Association for the cost of a retirement/separation party. The party must be held within six (6) months of retirement/separation, must open to all members of the OPOA, and the cost incurred will be reimbursed based upon the following maximum amounts:

- 1) More than **five** years of service, a reimbursement of up to **\$400.00**
- 2) More than **ten** years of service, a reimbursement of up to **\$800.00**
- 3) More than **fifteen** years of service, a reimbursement of up to **\$1,200.00**
- 4) More than **twenty** years of service, a reimbursement of up to **\$1,600.00**
- 5) More than **twenty-five** years of service, a reimbursement of up to **\$2,000.00**

The “years of service” must be within those classifications represented by the Oxnard Peace Officers’ Association as Class I or Class II members. Members are eligible for one separation party regardless of the number of times they separate from the City of Oxnard.

The liability for excessive expenditures for such a party is the responsibility of the retiree and/or those persons who organized the event. The OPOA does not assume any responsibility for cost overruns for such events.
